The total income of **€13,890.31** consists of membership fees, donations, and fundraising. We also received a **£4,996.07 (€5,831)** grant from the CSP (Critical Social Solidarity Fund - Stratford University UK) to organize a workshop to capacitate members in leadership positions.

With a total amount of **€4,373.55**, we implemented twenty-four aid projects in Nigeria and Cameroon in 2021. We provided political prisoners, displaced persons, and refugees with basic needs such as food, mattresses, bedding, clothing, soap, towels, and medicine. We supported many war victims. However, our main focus is on women, children and people with disabilities, as these are suffering the most from the crisis.

The administration costs amounted to **€1,230.14**. This sum was spent to purchase zoom link, printing papers, ink, postage stamps and envelopes. A small portion was given out as compensation to those who managed our social media platforms.

We spent **€1,950** on events and carried out political education. Despite the pandemic, we took part in some events and organized some ourselves to create awareness about the Anglophone crisis.

We participated at the event Black Lives Matter which was organized by the Left Party in Recklinghausen. We covered part of the transport costs for the 7 members who took part.

At the event in Cologne, for example, we had roll-ups and posters designed and produced. We also had t-shirts produced specifically for the event. We paid for the sanitation and location fee, hired a local broadcaster to broadcast the event LIVE on our social media platforms, and paid part of the transportation costs for members who participated and the co-organizers since they were students.
